

THIS INDENTURE made the thirtieth day of March in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty
nine BETWEEN GEORGE DIXON of the City of Carlisle
Esquire of the one part and THE REVEREND CHRISTOPHER
HILTON WYBERGH Vicar of the Vicarage and Parish Church
of Bromfield in the County of Cumberland Clerk and WILLIAM
BARNES of Scales JOSEPH GARNER of Blencogo JOHN
TIPPERON of Kelewick and THOMAS MANN of Crookhurst all
in the parish of Bromfield aforesaid the Churchwardens of
the said parish Church who are together hereinafter referred
to as the said Vicar and Churchwardens of the other part
WHEREAS the said George Dixon hath at his sole expense
erected upon land belonging to him in fee simple Schools in
the Township of Blencogo in the said parish of Bromfield
and hath appropriated the same with the yards and other
conveniences thereunto belonging for the education of the
Children of the labouring Classes resident in the said
Township of Blencogo or elsewhere in the said parish of
Bromfield AND he the said George Dixon is now desirous
of making an inalienable disposition of the said Schools
and premises in trust as hereinafter expressed NOW THIS
INDENTURE WITNESSETH that in pursuance of such desire and
as a free gift he the said George Dixon doth hereby give
grant alien and confirm unto the said Vicar and Churchwardens
and their respective successors ALL those Schoolhouses
lately erected by him the said George Dixon in the said
Township of Blencogo TOGETHER with the yards and other
conveniences to the same belonging or held used or to be used
therewith or deemed taken or known as part or parcel thereof
AND all the Estate right title interest claim and demand
whatsoever of the said George Dixon into and out of the said

premises expressed to be hereby granted TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Schoolhouses hereditaments and other the premises expressed to be hereby granted unto and to the use of the said Vicar and Churchwardens and their respective successors for ever nevertheless upon trust from time to time and at all times hereafter to permit and suffer the said Schools and premises expressed to be hereby granted to be used for the education of the children of the labouring classes resident in the said township of Blencogo or elsewhere in the said parish of Bromfield subject to such rules and conditions and in such manner in all respects as the Vicar for the time being of the said parish of Bromfield or other the resident minister for the time being of the said parish and the respective owners for the time being of the two Estates of the said George Dixon in the said Township of Blencogo called respectively Blencogo and Crocklands or any two of such three persons shall from time to time and at any time hereafter order and prescribe PROVIDED ALWAYS and it is hereby declared that it shall be lawful for the said three persons lastly mentioned or any two of them to authorise the use of the said Schools and premises hereby granted for Lectures or for any other purpose whereby the labouring classes of Bromfield aforesaid may be benefited so only that such use as last aforesaid do not interfere with the primary object of these presents the education of the children of the said labouring classes IN WITNESS whereof the said parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
